WHO WE ARE

In one of New York City's largest alliances, the Citywide Addiction Support Network (CASN) is bringing outpatient, inpatient and emergency addiction services directly to **individuals who need our services the most** throughout the Bronx, Manhattan and Queens.

CASN bands together 21 nonprofit and community-based behavioral health service providers in addition to the NYC Health + Hospitals system.

Together, the agencies of CASN are delivering prevention, treatment and recovery services to New Yorkers who are struggling with or at risk of opioid and stimulant use disorder.

Unique to our collection of services is a 24-hour hotline, managed by Samaritan Daytop Village, that connects individuals to Medication Assisted Treatment or Suboxone – a medication that helps reduce the cravings for and symptoms of opioid use disorder.

Additionally, a network of Certified Recovery Peer Specialists canvases public spaces throughout the three boroughs



to raise awareness of these services and refer individuals in need.

Opioids including:

- Fentanyl
- Heroin
- Painkillers

Stimulants such as:

- Cocaine
- Crack
- Methamphetamine
- Amphetamine

We serve adults, adolescents and teens from the Bronx, Manhattan and Queens.
Our culturally competent services respect the varied needs of our diverse population including the LGBTQ+ community.

Our vast array of free medical and behavioral health services provides new hope for the uninsured and underinsured.

We are also a lifeline to individuals who have been involved with the justice system or are currently on parole.

WHAT WE OFFER

More than 20 agencies have come together to deliver a complete range of prevention, treatment and recovery services across three boroughs.

Prevention

Our teams work to delay or prevent initiation of substance use among NYC youth. Support is provided around mental health and wellbeing as well as managing stress and trauma.

Support for Students Exposed to Trauma (SSET)

SSET helps middle schoolers manage distress caused by trauma. In a classroom setting, students learn important life skills to reduce the most common effects of post-traumatic stress disorder, including anxiety, withdrawal, depression, and impulsive or risky behavior.

■ Triple P - Positive Parenting Program

Triple P helps young parents expand their knowledge, skills and confidence. The program strives to reduce mental health, emotional and behavioral problems among children and adolescents.



Treatment

CASN connects individuals to behavioral health services providers, offering culturally competent, evidence-based treatment for substance use.

■ Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

MAT combines clinically approved medicine like Suboxone with counseling and behavioral therapies to help individuals stay in recovery. CASN increases access to care through its network of providers.

■ 24/7 Hotline and Referral Link

Individuals can call **718-206-1990** for safe, free access to addiction treatment or Suboxone (to reduce cravings and withdrawal symptoms). The 24/7 Hotline is run by Samaritan Daytop Village in Queens.

Access to Peer Specialists

A vital resource, peers connect individuals to CASN's vast network of medical and behavioral health services. CASN also has a team of Peer Outreach Specialists who canvas public spaces frequented by New Yorkers struggling with addiction.

Recovery

Peer Specialists, individuals with shared "lived experience," support and guide individuals in recovery from treatment and beyond.

CASN has dozens of Peer Specialists engaged with New Yorkers throughout the Bronx, Manhattan and Queens as well as with individuals involved with the justice system. A critical resource, Peer Specialists offer emotional support, remove barriers to recovery, and link to medical, educational, and financial services, among others.
