The Samaritan Daytop Village Social Care Network is a member of WholeYouNYC, a community-based network of Medicaid-approved service providers specializing in enhanced care management, food and nutrition, housing assistance, and non-medical transportation. Combined, the resources in this valuable database are focused on improving or maintaining health, well-being, and overall quality of life.

HOW IT WORKS

Let us jumpstart your Enhanced Care Management journey. Our team consists of Social Care Navigators, individuals who work with you one-on-one to locate available, Medicaid-approved social services for recipients residing in Brooklyn, Manhattan, and Queens.

A Social Care Navigator screens you to determine your health-related social needs. You will then be matched with available resources in WholeYouNYC's network. With your consent, the

Social Care Navigator will contact the provider on your behalf. *(We can also refer you to Samaritan Daytop Village services or programs that may be a good fit.)*

Within one week, your Social Care Navigator will follow up. If, for any reason, you need to find a new or additional resource, we will identify and refer you to an alternative.

ENHANCED CARE MANAGEMENT

Access specialized care management, coordination, and support services



FOOD & NUTRITION

Receive SNAP application and benefit support, food pantry referrals, and nutrition education and support



TRANSPORTATION

Find non-medical transportation to and from appointments, services, and essential needs



HOUSING

Locate resources to assist with TANF, rental voucher information, and referrals to housing programs and services

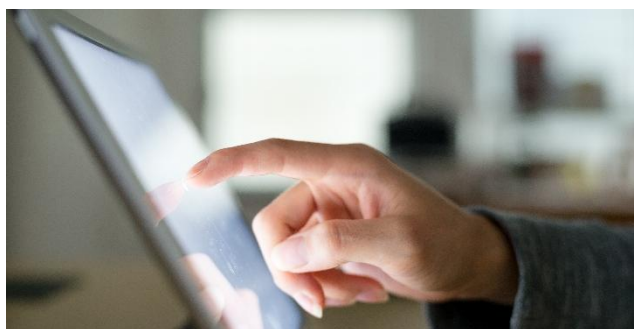
